


# Advance Scholarship

# What is an Advance Scholarship?



The Advance Scholarship is for Bridge Housing residents who have employment and/or learning goals or want to improve their children's experience of school.



If you are in training or engaged in an apprenticeship, a student (school, TAFE and University included), or a parent who is seeking to improve your child's experience at school, then an Advance Scholarship may be able to support you with financial assistance to help you achieve your employment and education goals.

## How much can I apply for?

The Advance Scholarships are available by age group:

- ▶ Primary School students: up to \$750
- ▶ High School students: up to \$1000
- ▶ Tertiary Education or Professional Development: up to \$1500.

## Who is eligible to apply?

- ▶ You must be a tenant or household member of Bridge Housing
- ▶ You must be applying for an activity or item that will:
  - ▶ Improve your employment prospects OR
  - ▶ Improve your child's experience of school
- ▶ Applicants must not be in any rent, water or other arrears. Any previous arrears must be being paid through a consistent repayment plan.
- ▶ Not be the recipient of a FACS scholarship in the same year you are applying
- ▶ Affordable and transitional housing are not eligible to apply.



## What can I apply for?

- ▶ Physical or cultural extra-curricular activities such as swimming lessons, cultural dance or team sports
- ▶ Courses or certificates that will assist with professional development and/or gaining employment
- ▶ Education related costs.





## How will Bridge Housing decide who receives a scholarship?

All successful applicants must meet the eligibility criteria and in addition:

- ▶ Apply for activities or items that are most likely to assist them in
  - ▶ Achieving employment or professional development goals
  - ▶ Improve their child's experience of school
- ▶ Provide evidence of the cost of the item applied for.
- ▶ Demonstrate clear goals for themselves or their children


Preference will be given to applicants who have not previously received a scholarship.



## How do I apply for a scholarship?

All applicants must fill out the short application form attached to these guidelines and post to Bridge Housing or email to: [customerservice@bridgehousing.org.au](mailto:customerservice@bridgehousing.org.au)

If you need help filling in the form, please let us know. We can discuss your application with you and help you to fill it in. You can also ask your support provider to apply on your behalf.



## Can I receive more than one scholarship?

You can apply for more than one scholarship, however, the following limits apply:

- ▶ Maximum of 2 scholarships per household per year
- ▶ Maximum of 1 scholarship per individual per year
- ▶ Maximum of \$3,000 for any one household over their tenancy
- ▶ Where demand is greater than the budget for the scholarships preference will be given to those households who have not previously received a scholarship.

## What happens if I am approved for a scholarship?

You will sign an agreement that outlines the purpose of the scholarship given, the amount you will receive and how the funds will be paid.

All scholarship recipients will be asked to provide feedback about the program and how the scholarship helped you and/or your family. You will also be asked if you would like to be involved in future promotion of the Advance Scholarship program. This may include providing photos or quotes.





## How are the scholarship funds delivered?

Bridge Housing will pay for the activity or item directly to the supplier or school. You will need to provide evidence of the costs and charges by supplying quotes or invoices with your application. In situations where this is not possible and you are able to cover the costs of the activity or item, Bridge Housing will be able to reimburse you for costs. Sufficient evidence must be provided.

Retrospective purchases will not be eligible for reimbursement.
