

Be Involved, Have your Say

What is The Tenant Advisory Group? (TAG)

Bridge Housing aims to provide the best possible services to its tenants. We understand that to achieve this Bridge Housing needs to consider the views and experiences of the communities in which its works and operates. As a result, one of our priorities is to encourage our tenants and residents to be involved in what we do. The TAG was set up to achieve this. It is a way in which Bridge Housing can gain feedback from you as a Bridge Housing tenant, on the policies we follow and the decisions that we make.

How does TAG work?

TAG is a network of local meetings which aims to discuss issues and exchange ideas between Bridge Housing and tenants. The meetings also serve as a means for tenants to bring problems they may be experiencing on a local level to Bridge Housing's attention.

Each group is tenant led which keeps the theme of each meeting relevant and focussed on issues or problems that may have an impact on you.

The Chair of our TAG meets with the Bridge Housing General Manager of Housing and Community monthly and reports to board meetings every 6 months to update them on key issues discussed at TAG.

When does TAG meet?

All our TAG meetings meet every two months.

The Central TAG meets in Redfern and discusses issues that affect tenants across the whole of the organisation.

The Fast TAG meets in Bondi, the West TAG meets in Parramatta and the Rozelle TAG meets in Rozelle (see the chart below). The aim of these meetings is to discuss issues that affect tenants at a more local level.

We realise our tenants may not have the opportunity to attend the regular meetings. This doesn't mean you can't get involved in what's happening. Your TAG representatives are keen to hear from you, contact details can be found on the back of this brochure.
