# **Block Meetings**

### **Purpose**

This policy provides guidance about how and when Bridge Housing will conduct a Block Meeting.

### Scope

This policy applies to all housing managers and tenants living in blocks managed by Bridge Housing (we, our, us).

## **Policy**

We define a 'Block' as any building where there are four or more of our tenants living in the same complex.

We will generally organise a Block Meeting where:

- Major repairs or construction are scheduled to provide information about the work and answer questions from tenants
- There are common area issues that require agreement between tenants, for example management of bins or parking, and/or
- There is a proposal for a community garden or Big Ideas Grant for the block.

#### The purpose of a block meeting

Block meetings provide a forum for us to meet with tenants to discuss and resolve shared issues, share important information and to support community initiatives.

The purpose of a Block meeting is to:

- Resolve issues raised by tenants on the spot wherever possible
- Provide an opportunity for tenants to ask questions and provide suggestions and possible solutions to shared issues
- Encourage tenants to get involved in community-led initiatives.

Block meetings are not common area property inspections or maintenance audits. Tenants are encouraged to report repairs to Bridge Housing's repairs line. They do not replace the need to meet and report issues to their Housing Manager on an individual basis.

#### **Block Meeting Organisation**

Meetings are organised by the Housing Manager responsible for the portfolio. Tenants and household members are encouraged to attend. Tenants will receive an invitation and agenda for the block meeting at least 2 weeks in advance.

We will post a written summary of the outcomes of the meeting within 1 week of the meeting.
