- ▶ Invite your neighbours to gather together for a BBQ or picnic at a local park
- ▶ Join a local walking group, check out the City of Sydney website for details of specific groups

- ▶ Travel all day on Sunday on trains, buses, ferries and light rail using your Opal card and pay no more than \$2.60 per person
- ▶ Bushwalk in Sydney Harbour National Park, where there's plenty of tracks to choose from varying in length and difficulty
- ▶ Join in the Yabun Festival on Friday 26 January. Entry is free and the festival celebrates Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander culture by showcasing some of the best Indigenous music, dancing and entertainment in the country
- ▶ Explore the Art Gallery of New South Wales or the MCA's free exhibits.

# Maintenance Myth Busters

**Emergency repairs**  
Always call the repairs line immediately on 02 8324 0886

Emergencies repairs are things like a major water or gas leak, a sewer or waste pipe blockage, a dangerous electrical fault or structural damage. The response time for emergency repairs is **4 hours**.

**Urgent repairs**  
Always call the repairs line immediately on 02 8324 0886

Urgent repairs include smoke alarm failures, no power to the property, no hot water and trip hazards in your home or common area. The response time for emergency repairs is **24 hours**.

**Routine and Non urgent repairs**

Can be reported via the maintenance line on 02 8324 0886 or via the online Report a Repair service on the Bridge Housing website. The response time varies between **5 and 21 days** depending on the issue.

**Screen doors and fly screens**

Bridge Housing will only maintain screen doors that were already there when you moved in. New screen doors will not be installed by Bridge on existing properties. If you would like to install a screen door at your own cost, complete the Alterations Application Form. You will then be responsible for all maintenance for the items you install.

**Air-conditioning**

Bridge Housing will only maintain air-conditioning units that were there when you moved in. If you would like to install air-conditioning at your own cost, you must submit an Alterations Application Form.

**Carpet and flooring**

Carpet is replaced based on our technical scoping and life cycle upgrade program over a 10-15 year cycle. If you wish to remove or replace the carpet in your home at your own cost, please complete the Alterations Application Form.

**Pay TV and antennas**

Complete the Alterations Application Form to request approval for installation before you sign a contract with a Pay TV service provider.

**Contractors**

Our contractors have signed up to a Code of Conduct (you can read this on our website) and they must adhere to safety standards including attending your home within the designated response times, completing subsequent works and wearing identification.

**Smoke Alarms**

We complete annual checks on your smoke alarms. If you have any concerns about any fire related equipment within your home please call the repairs line on 02 8324 0886.

## Fire Services Safety Notice - Door Self Closers

Do not remove the self-closer from your door, it is designed to automatically close the door so if a fire occurs within your unit it is contained. This gives you and other people more time to escape.

If you are experiencing issues with your door closer please call the Repairs Team on **8324 0886** who will be able to assist with any repairs.



If you have a medical condition which causes you to struggle with the current closer in place please call the asset team who can provide advice and discuss options to assist you.

If the fire safety contractor attends your home for the annual inspection and you have removed or disconnected your closer, you will be charged for the re-installation or replacement.

## Bond Refunds

Bridge Housing is no longer taking bonds for social housing tenancies. We will be refunding all bonds for social housing tenants in the near future. If you are a social housing tenant, please keep an eye out for communication from us. To ensure your bond is refunded to you as quickly as possible, make sure you take any action required from you.

## CEO Update

It is already November and I'm catching my breath on how fast Bridge Housing has moved through 2017 and what an exciting and successful year it has been.



The big news is that in October the Minister for Family and Community Services, the Hon. Pru Goward announced that Bridge Housing, in partnership with Women's Housing Company, secured the Social Housing Management transfer tender for the Northern Beaches portfolio of 1200 properties. The transfer of tenancy management will begin in 2018 and take place over a period of 18 months. We have planned well ahead to make sure that the transfer will go smoothly for our new Northern Beaches tenants to ensure they will feel welcome and supported by Bridge Housing. As importantly, we will continue to deliver the same level of customer service to our existing residents.

Domestic violence is a dreadful scourge and Bridge Housing is committed to its elimination and recognising

it as a workplace issue. We have recently completed an 18-month process developing a comprehensive response to violence against women in the workplace and I am proud to say that Bridge Housing has achieved White Ribbon Accreditation and joins 122 workplaces across the private, government and not for profit sectors.

I am also very proud that Bridge Housing's groundbreaking Hand Up rent arrears management program was recognised with an industry award at this year's Australasian Housing Institute NSW awards in July 2017.

We were very busy this year improving our properties with new bin bays and fencing at Wauhope Cres South Coogee, upgrades at Laggan Ave Balmain, PVC window and door frames at Henson

St Summer Hill, all in addition to the regular responsive repairs and maintenance and cyclic upgrades.

I want to personally thank tenants who attended our workshops and meetings this year and all those who have taken time out of your busy schedules to assist with our Reconciliation Action Plan, provide feedback, share your views and attend Bridge Housing events.

# Bridge Housing on the Northern Beaches

Bridge Housing was recently announced as the successful winners of the Northern Beaches package in the Social Housing Management Transfer program. The Northern Beaches portfolio includes more than 1,200 properties and will expand our current housing portfolio from around 2,000 to more than 3,100 properties.

Over the last year we have been talking to staff and tenants about preparing for growth. Tenants gave us great feedback about what we need to concentrate on - both for new tenants transferred from Housing NSW and for existing tenants. We will continue to focus on providing a high level of customer service for all households, suitable housing and support services, and ensuring that tenants and household members have a real say in the way we do things.
